

PITCHING RULES

Column A- The number in this column represents the most innings a pitcher can pitch in 1 day and still pitch the next day.

Column B- The number in this column represents the most innings a pitcher can pitch in 1 days.

Column C- The number in this column represents the most innings a pitcher can pitch in 2 consecutive days.

Division	A	B	C
9 & under	4	6	8
10& under	4	6	8
11 & under	4	6	9
12 & under	4	6	9
13 & under	5	7	11
14 & under	5	7	11

- A pitcher removed before any outs are made will be charged with 1/3 inning.
- Pitcher will be charged with 3 outs if inning is ended by the 6 or 7 Run limit and the pitcher pitched the entire inning.
